DRC-CONGO

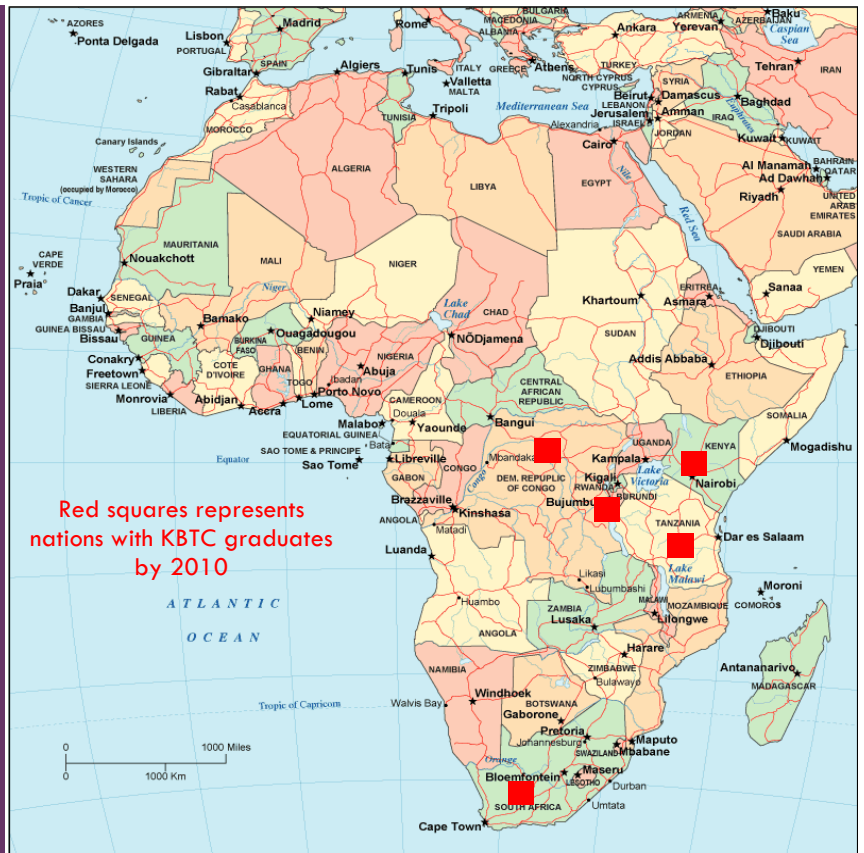
We have been granted a certificate of registration to establish the ministry in this nation. 3 pastors have been trained at KBTC. They have also planted and established 6 local churches in this nation.

You Must Belong Before You Can GO!

Christ has commissioned His disciples to carry out the Great Commission, so everything else in life is subservient to that God-given responsibility. **Mark 16: 15-18.**

The Great Commission is fulfilled through the work of the local church in making disciples, baptizing them, and teaching them to observe all that Christ commands. The outgrowth of each local church obeying this commission enables a connection with other churches among all the nations. The church is referred to in **1 Timothy 3:15** as the house of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and ground of the Truth. It clearly establishes the local assembly as the centerpiece of God's work in this dispensation.

If you'll notice, during the time of Jesus' ministry on the earth, he elected His disciples and trained them to serve with him first for a while before he released them to serve others on their own. After spending time with the Lord in His earthly ministry, He commanded them again to wait until they were endued with power of the Holy Ghost before stepping out in the ministry. In Acts chapter 2, they were empowered by the Holy Spirit and they went out serving others, and the Lord Jesus working with them with signs and wonders following. They had been proven and they were eligible to be trusted. Notice there was the Lord's part – **to train** and there was their part **to obey**.

As they stepped out in obedience to what he asked them to do, they experienced his provision and witnessed salvation, great power and protection. **Mark 16:16-18**

We see clearly that the power to perform the works of God is directly related to our obedience in the local body. What is the Lord calling you to do in your local church, job or even in the community you live in? Do you know your assignment for the hour and are you willing to serve your master where He has placed you?

The local church is a place where authority is designated and where members of the Body of Christ are elected by leadership to fill various positions so that the work of

the Lord can be carried out effectively. It is a place where direction is given and obedience is proven.

Great power has been bestowed upon a believer but I also believe they have to be trained and trusted to use that power. That is one major reason; we are bringing the training in the nations and equipping them so that they can effectively do the work of the ministry to which they are called. We strongly endorse the agenda of raising strong local churches as well.

Much ministry is needed in a local church including childrens ministry, youth, ushering, singers, musicians, and prayers and so on. As you serve faithfully in your local church, the Lord will confirm his Word with signs following. As you prove faithful in your local church, God will bless you mightily in your relationships with other members of the Body of Christ around the world and in your calling. Many are not experiencing the flow of the blessings of the Lord today in their lives because they have not obeyed in the little things that the Lord has asked them to do in their local churches. The Bible declares that the Lord will **ONLY** make you ruler over much if He can trust you with that which is little. That could include responsibilities awarded to you by the leadership of a local church. For us, as Christians to be effective in the harvest fields, we must submit ourselves and learn how to serve one another in our local churches and among our family members. We must demonstrate the love of God one for each other. Our love walk must touch those who are around us. Please study **1 Corinthians 13**.

Purpose to spend time with the Lord. Receive guidance and direction from His presence. Come out and serve others with the Lord. When you do that, you will experience greater joy in the work of the Lord to which you have been called and signs and wonders will also follow.
